





IAEA Technical Meeting

September 23 – 27, 2013 Mumbai, India

Overview

International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) has proposed to organize a Technical Meeting on *Guiding Principles for Applying Computer Security to Instrumentation and Control Systems at Nuclear facilities* during September 23-27, 2013 at Mumbai, India.

The purpose of the meeting is to develop and review areas that should be addressed in the IAEA guidance on computer security for digital instrumentation and control systems at nuclear facilities to include the integration of safety and security considerations during the lifecycle of digital control systems.

Organization & Participation

Control Instrumentation Division (CnID) of Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), Mumbai is organizing the meeting. The funding for the event is provided by the Global Centre of Nuclear Energy Partnership (GCNEP), Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Government of India.

Nominated members from various units of DAE along with invited foreign delegates and representatives of IAEA would attend the meeting. The total number of participants is expected to be around 20.

The meeting will be held at The Regenza by Tunga, a hotel at Navi Mumbai during the office hours from September 23 – 27, 2013. On the opening day of the meeting, Shri. C. K.
